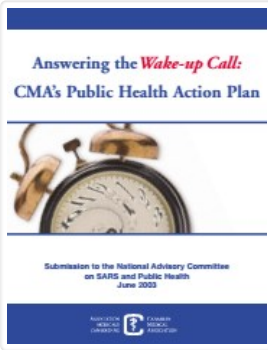

He should have hospital privileges and should participate in the active care of patients in hospitals. His core training should include training in obstetrics.
